He has more than 33 years experience in technical and vocational education and has worked as Principal of a polytechnic and as Deputy Director of the Polytechnic Management Division, Vice Principal and Head of Mechanical Engineering at different polytechnics.

Dr. Mohamed Rashid bin Navi Bax holds a B.Sc (Hons) in Automation Engineering from the City University, London; both M.S. (Industrial Technical Vocational Education) and Ph.D (Industrial Education & Technology) from Iowa State University, USA.
