

John E. Davies is an Intel Vice President, and General Manager of the Intel World Ahead Program. The program promotes increased access to technology and connects millions of people in emerging markets to technology for the first time. Doing so helps improve education and healthcare, stimulate economies, and enrich lives around the world.

During his 32 years with Intel, Mr. Davies has worked in senior engineering, marketing, and management positions. He has been Director of Marketing for the Mobile Computing Group, and VP/marketing director for the Consumer Desktop Products group. In addition, he was VP and General Manager of Intel's Asia Pacific Region.

Mr. Davies was born in London, England. He received his B.S. in Chemistry and his Ph.D. in Solid State Physics from Imperial College, London University. Prior to joining Intel, he worked as a postdoctoral research fellow at IBM, and as a development engineer at Philips in the UK.

Intel has awarded Mr. Davies two prestigious Individual Achievement Awards: for establishing Intel in the European automotive market, and for bringing Intel's mobile computing architecture into the Japanese market. In 2010, he won Latin Trade's BRAVO award for 2010 Technology Leader of the Year.
